## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The proposed legislation requires the University of Wisconsin System, the Wisconsin Technical College System, the Department of Public Instruction, and the Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities to establish a longitudinal data system of student data that links such data from preschool programs through postsecondary education programs.

The UW System anticipates increased costs to build and maintain a longitudinal data system. The actual fiscal effect of this legislation cannot be determined with the information provided.
