

116.23 PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTIONS.

Subdivision 1.Nutrient concentrations.

No person shall manufacture for use or sale in Minnesota or import into Minnesota for resale any cleaning agent or chemical water conditioner which contains a prescribed nutrient in a concentration that is greater than the prescribed maximum permissible concentration of that nutrient in that cleaning agent or chemical water conditioner.

Subd. 2.Residential dishwasher detergent.

No person shall sell, distribute, offer, or expose for sale at retail any household dishwasher detergent that contains more than 0.5 percent phosphorus by weight. This subdivision does not apply to the sale or distribution of detergents for commercial or institutional dishwashing purposes.

Subd. 2. **Residential dishwasher detergent.** No person shall sell, distribute, offer, 1.13 or expose for sale at retail any household dishwasher detergent that contains more than 0.5 1.14 percent phosphorus by weight. This subdivision does not apply to the sale or distribution 1.15 of detergents for commercial or institutional dishwashing purposes.

1.16 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.17 Section 1 is effective July 1, 2010.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits the sale of cleaning products, other than industrial cleaning products, that contain more than specified amounts of phosphorus. The limit for most cleaning products is 0.5 percent phosphorus by weight. The limit for machine dishwashing products is 8.7 percent phosphorus by weight.

This bill reduces the limit on the amount of phosphorus in machine
> dishwashing products for household use to 0.5 percent. The bill does not change the
limit for nonhousehold machine dishwashing products.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 100.28 (2) (a) and (b) of the statutes are amended to read:
4 100.28 (2) (a) *General restriction; 0.5%.* Any cleaning agent which contains
5 more than 0.5% phosphorus by weight, other than a cleaning agent for nonhousehold
6 machine dishwashing or for cleansing of medical and surgical equipment.
