

340.01 VEHICLES – GENERAL PROVISIONS

“All-terrain vehicle” means an engine-driven device which has a net weight of 900 pounds or less, which has is originally manufactured with a width of ~~48~~ 50 inches or less, which is equipped with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator and which is designed by the manufacturer to travel on 3 or more low-pressure tires.

> This bill increases the maximum width of an ATV to 50 inches. The bill specifies that the width of an ATV must be 50 inches at the time of manufacture and
> that it be designed by the manufacturer to travel on ^{three} or more low pressure tires in order to meet the definition. As to the requirements for a low pressure tire, the bill eliminates the requirement for the size of the rim and increases the the maximum operating pressure for a low-pressure tire to ten pounds per square inch.
