



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 258**

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 287.95 (1); and *to create* 287.07 (4m) of the statutes; **relating**  
2           **to:** the disposal of used automotive engine oil filters and oil absorbent materials  
3           and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4           **SECTION 1.** 287.07 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:  
5           287.07 **(4m)** OIL FILTERS AND OIL ABSORBENT MATERIALS. (a) In this subsection:  
6           1. “Automotive engine oil” has the meaning given in s. 287.15 (1) (a).  
7           2. “Oil absorbent materials” means materials that are used to absorb waste oil.  
8           3. “Oil filter” means a filter for automotive engine oil.  
9           4. “Waste oil” means any petroleum–derived or synthetic oil that has been used  
10          or spilled.

1 (b) Beginning on the first day of the 13th month beginning after publication ...  
2 [LRB inserts date], no person may do any of the following:

- 3 1. Dispose of a used oil filter in a solid waste disposal facility.  
4 2. Dispose of oil absorbent materials that contain waste oil in a solid waste  
5 disposal facility, except as provided in par. (c).

6 (c) Paragraph (b) 2. does not apply to the disposal of less than one gallon of oil  
7 absorbent materials that contain waste oil resulting from a nonroutine spill.

8 **SECTION 2.** 287.95 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 287.95 (1) Any person who violates s. 287.07 (1m) or (4m) may be required to  
10 forfeit \$50 for a first violation, may be required to forfeit \$200 for a 2nd violation and  
11 may be required to forfeit not more than \$2,000 for a 3rd or subsequent violation.
