AN ACT *to amend* 287.95 (1); and *to create* 287.07 (4m) of the statutes; **relating** to: the disposal of used automotive engine oil filters and oil absorbent materials and providing a penalty.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits various items and substances, including lead acid batteries, major appliances, and waste oil, from being disposed of in landfills.

This bill prohibits the disposal in landfills of used automotive oil filters and materials that have been used to absorb spilled or used automotive engine oil. The prohibition takes effect a year after the bill is enacted.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 287.07 (4m) of the statutes is created to read:
  - 287.07 (4m) OIL FILTERS AND OIL ABSORBENT MATERIALS. (a) In this subsection:
- 6 1. "Automotive engine oil" has the meaning given in s. 287.15 (1) (a).
- 7 2. "Oil absorbent materials" means materials that are used to absorb spilled or used oil.
