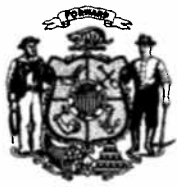

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 115.28 (55) of the statutes; **relating to:** the model academic

4 115.28 (55) SOCIAL STUDIES STANDARDS. Incorporate the history of organized
