



**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 236**

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 118.33 (1) (a) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** high school science
2 credits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.33 (1) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
4 118.33 (1) (a) 1. In the high school grades, at least 4 credits of English including
5 writing composition, 3 credits of social studies including state and local government,
6 2 credits of mathematics, 2 credits of science and 1.5 credits of physical education.
7 The school board shall award a pupil a science credit for successfully completing in
8 the high school grades each course in agriculture that the department has
9 determined qualifies as science according to criteria established by the department.
