Ott, Nerison, Lothian, Tauchen, Spanbauer, Molepske Jr., Jorgensen, Gunderson, Hixson and Vruwink, cosponsored by Senators Vinehout, Taylor, Olsen, Hansen and Kedzie. Referred to Committee on Education.

AN ACT *to amend* 118.33 (1) (am) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring that certain high school agriculture courses be counted as science credits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a school board may not grant a high school diploma to any pupil unless the pupil has earned, in grades 9 to 12, at least four credits of English, three credits of social studies, two credits of mathematics, two credits of science, and 1.5 credits of physical education.

This silk provides that if a pupil carry at least two endits in science of school board award pupil and science credit for completing in grades 9 to 12 each course in agriculture that the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has determined qualifies as science according to criteria established by DPI.
