



2009 SENATE BILL 284

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 84.1051 of the statutes; **relating to:** designating and marking
2 USH 63 as the Gaylord Nelson Highway.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 84.1051 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **84.1051 Gaylord Nelson Highway. (1)** The department shall designate and,
5 subject to sub. (2), mark the entire route of USH 63 as the “Gaylord Nelson Highway”
6 in recognition and appreciation of Gaylord Nelson, the native son of Clear Lake who
7 served with distinction as both the governor from 1959 to 1963 and a U.S. senator
8 from 1963 to 1981, and whose legacy includes numerous environmental
9 achievements, including the founding of Earth Day, the creation of the
10 Knowles–Nelson Stewardship Program, and the preservation of the Apostle Islands
11 in Lake Superior.
