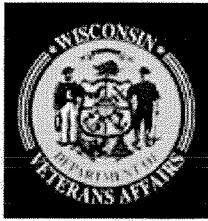

Hi Christian,

When I followed this link to the links for the 9 listed veterans memorials, about half of those links did not work. Through other searches, I found most of these memorials but not all. The issues that I need to follow up on are:

1. I could not identify the memorial related to the link "Erin, Wisconsin - Washington County."
2. I could not identify a specific memorial for "Wisconsin Civil War Memorials - Sons of Union Veterans." I did find another link listing more than 20 memorials of types "rang[ing] from a statue or cannons in a park, to a stained glass GAR window in a church or even a commemorative plaque on a wall." See <http://www.suvcw-wi.org/memorials.html>
3. The last listed link "Wisconsin State Memorial - Vicksburg National Military Park" is not in WI; it's in MS.
4. The list does not include the Wisconsin Veterans Museum in Madison, which I guess is a museum and not a memorial but perhaps might be worthy of listing.

Can you let me know how you want to deal with these items?

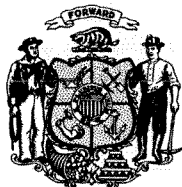

Thank you again for allowing us to have input in this bill as your office is having it drafted. It looks very good, and is probably ready for circulation for co-sponsorship as it is.

There are just a handful of minor changes that probably should be made before formal introduction:

1. The drafter misspelled "cemetery" throughout the bill.
2. Item "k" should probably be revised to mirror the style of item "j" before it: j) Wisconsin Veterans Home at King .... and k) Wisconsin Veterans Home at Union Grove .... are the formal titles to the two Homes. [When there used to be just one, it was called and is still labeled on the state highway map as simply "Wisconsin Veterans Home". Alternately, "Wisconsin Veterans Home-King" and "Wisconsin Veterans Home-Union Grove" would be fine, too.
3. Item "g", the cemetery is *near* the City of Spooner (but is physically *in* the township of Beaver Brook).
4. Items "h" and "k" -- the cemetery and home are *near* the Village of Union Grove (but located on the campus of the Southern Wisconsin Center for the Developmentally Disabled, which I believe but am not certain straddles the townships of York and Dover).

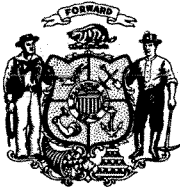

1 AN ACT *to create* 84.02 (5) (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** highway maps  
2 published by the Department of Transportation.

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***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to publish highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system and folded highway maps of the state. Under current law, numerous state trunk highways and bridges have been designated in various ways as veterans memorials.

This bill requires DOT to identify on the highway service maps and folded highway maps it publishes for sale or distribution to the public each veterans memorial highway or bridge and the location of specified veterans memorials, homes, and museums.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

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***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***
