Dean -

As we discussed this morning, section 118.019 (2) (e). The material that had been included under s. 118.019 (2) (e) is both modified in this bill and sprinkled throughout s. 118.019 (2) (a) - (d). You indicated that "Leah would to have the local school boards decide who & what will be instructed as far as what is/was contained in sec 118.(2)(e)." As I interpret this instruction, and just to be perfectly clear:

1. Rep. Vukmir wants school boards to decide what is to be included in the curriculum, not DPI.

To accomplish this objective, I will eliminate from s. 118.019 (2) all of the material beginning with the words "If provided..." on page 4, line 15 and ending with "...violent relationships" on p. 5, line 24 and substitute language that permits the school board to decide what to include in the curriculum. I will also eliminate the definition of "medically accurate information" provided on p. 4.

Is that correct?

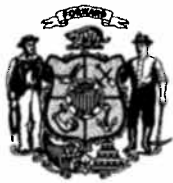
2. Your instruction regarding volunteer health care providers is a bit less clear. Does Rep. Vukmir want volunteer health care providers to teach what school boards decide is to be included in the curriculum under s. 118.019 (2)? Or not to teach any of this at all?
