Dear Senator Sullivan,

I am writing in regards to Senate Bill 324 which pertains to Human Growth and Development in Public Schools. Currently in the West Allis – West Milwaukee School District we offer two courses on this topic. One course provides students with the full compliment of information which is named in the proposal for SB-324. Our second class is an abstinence ONLY class which is available for any students whose parents opt them out of the first offering.

It is our understanding that this bill currently sits in Senator John Lehman's Education Committee but is expected to be voted out of committee on Wednesday, January 27, 2010. We have some concerns with the bill in its current form and would like to see some language added. Specifically what we would like an amendment added: ***that if Public School Districts already offer or have interest in offering an abstinence only course that they be allowed to do so as part of the opt out alternative.*** We feel that by allowing school districts to offer this type of a course we are better able to meet the needs and wishes of our parents, students and school community.

Please consider this information before you make your vote on this bill.

1. Page 4, line 15: delete "If" and substitute "Except as permitted in sub. (2p),

2. Page 5, line 25: after that line insert:

"SECTION 118.019 (2p) of the statutes is created to read:

6 118.019 (2p) ABSTINENCE-ONLY HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT. (a) In  
7 addition to the instructional program provided under sub. (2), a school board may  
8 offer courses in abstinence-only human growth and development. Courses offered  
9 under this subsection shall be made available to any pupil whose parent or guardian  
10 submits a written request that his or her child take instruction in abstinence-only  
11 human growth and development.

(b) A school board that elects to offer courses in abstinence-only human growth

and development may establish policies to determine all of the following:

1           1. The subjects, identified under sub. (2), to be included in and excluded from  
2 the abstinence-only human growth and development curriculum.

3           2. Whether to offer an abstinence-only human growth and development course  
4 in any grade in any particular school year. Policies developed under this subdivision  
5 may include consideration of the level of interest in abstinence-only human growth  
6 and development courses among the parents and guardians of pupils enrolled in the  
7 school district.

8           (c) A school board that elects to offer courses in abstinence-only human growth  
9 and development shall provide to the parent or guardian of each child who is enrolled  
10 in an abstinence-only human growth and development course a complete list of all  
11 subjects identified under sub. (2) that will not be covered in the course offered under  
12 this subsection.”

13           3. Page 6, line 12: after “classroom.” insert “If a school board offers an  
14 abstinence-only human growth and development curriculum as permitted under  
15 sub. (2p), the school board shall make the complete abstinence-only human growth  
16 and development curriculum and all instructional materials available for inspection  
17 by a parent or guardian upon his or her request at any time, including prior to their  
18 use in the classroom.”

19           4. Page 6, line 25: after that line insert:

20           “SECTION 9g. 118.019 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:  
21           118.019 (4) EXEMPTION FOR INDIVIDUAL PUPILS. No pupil may be required to take  
22 instruction in human growth and development or abstinence-only human growth  
23 and development or in the specific subjects under either sub. (2) or (2p) if the pupil’s

③ ✓ SECTION 9r. 118.019 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 118.019 (5) ADVISORY COMMITTEE. In any school district that offers a human  
5 growth and development curriculum, including an abstinence-only human growth  
6 and development curriculum, the school board shall appoint an advisory committee  
7 composed of parents, teachers, school administrators, pupils, health care  
8 professionals, members of the clergy, and other residents of the school district. The  
9 advisory committee shall develop the human growth and development curriculum  
10 and, if applicable, the abstinence-only human growth and development curriculum,  
11 and advise the school board on the design, review, and implementation of the  
12 advisory committee's human growth and development curriculum. The advisory  
13 committee shall review the curriculum at least every 3 years.”.
