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

**SENATE AMENDMENT ,  
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 2**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: after “(1r)” insert “(a)”.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 5: delete “(a)” and substitute “1.”.

4 **3.** Page 2, line 7: delete “(b)” and substitute “2.”.

5 **4.** Page 2, line 9: delete “(c)” and substitute “3.”.

6 **5.** Page 2, line 10: delete “paragraph” and substitute “subdivision”.

7 **6.** Page 2, line 11: delete “(d)” and substitute “4.”.

8 **7.** Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

9 “(b) On or before August 1 of each odd-numbered year, the department shall  
10 submit a report to the chief clerk of each house of the legislature under s. 13.172 (2)  
11 describing the following:

1           1. How many times in each of the fiscal years in the previous fiscal biennium  
2 the requirement under par. (a) affected the purchase of contractual services.

3           2. For each instance under subd. 1., the difference between the actual cost of  
4 the contractual services when the requirement under par. (a) applied to the purchase  
5 and the presumed cost, to the best of the department's knowledge, of the contractual  
6 services if the requirement under par. (a) ~~did not apply~~ to the purchase.".
