Statutory Printing Exemption

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Move to modify current law to exempt the Historical Society from using the state printing contract for all books published by the Society.

Note:

Under current law, the Historical Society is exempted from using the state printing contract for its publications intended for resale, specifically, hard cover books and for the *Wisconsin Magazine of History*. However, paperback books are not provided with this exemption, because the words "hard bound" are included in the statute. The Society indicates that the quality of its paperback publications has suffered as a result. The motion would delete the words "hard bound" from the governing statute.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, subject to certain exceptions, all book printing required for state agencies is subject to certain requirements relating to the publication of public documents, including certain specification, bidding, and contracting requirements (public printing requirements). Hard bound books of the State Historical Society (SHS), however, are exempt from the public printing requirements. Instead the printing of hard bound books of the SHS must be procured on individual competitive bids and by an official state printing order according to specifications determined by the Department of Administration. This bill exempts all books of the SHS, whether \(\) hard bound or paperback, from the public printing requirements.

an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 35.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

35.01 (3) Class 3—All book printing required for state agencies, not otherwise classified, except university press publications and technical or semitechnical

- journals of the University of Wisconsin System, the Wisconsin magazine of history
- 2 <u>Magazine of History</u>, and hard bound books of the historical society.
