2009 SENATE BILL 410

December 2, 2009 – Introduced by Senators COGGS and TAYLOR, cosponsored by Representatives YOUNG, TURNER, BERCEAU, A. WILLIAMS, BARCA, PASCH and FIELDS. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Tourism, Forestry, and Natural Resources.

1 **AN ACT to create** 84.1051 of the statutes; **relating to:** designating and marking
2 a portion of I 43 in the city of Milwaukee as the Jeannetta Simpson–Robinson
3 Memorial Highway.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals, groups, or events. This bill directs the Department of Transportation (DOT) to designate and mark a portion of the route of I 43 within the city of Milwaukee as the “Jeannetta Simpson–Robinson Memorial Highway” in recognition and appreciation of the good works of Jeannetta Simpson–Robinson, a lifelong community leader and activist, who championed the poor, the disadvantaged, children, and peaceful non–violent resolutions to conflicts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 84.1051 of the statutes is created to read:

**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 410**

February 1, 2010 – Offered by Senator COGGS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after “**Highway.**” insert “**(1)**”.

3 **2.** Page 1, line 6: after “and” insert “, subject to sub. (2)”,

4 **3.** Page 2, line 6: after that line insert:

5 “(2) Upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, including
6 any county, city, village, or town, to cover the costs of erecting and maintaining
7 markers along the route specified in sub. (1) to clearly identify to motorists the
8 designation of the route as the “Jeannetta Simpson–Robinson Memorial Highway,”
9 the department shall erect and maintain the markers. No state funds, other than
10 from the receipt of contributions under this subsection, may be expended for the
11 erection or maintenance of the markers”.
