### 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 375

August 18, 2009 – Introduced by Representatives Shilling and Huebsch, cosponsored by Senator Kapanke. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

AN ACT to create 70.11 (45) of the statutes; relating to: a property tax exemption

for certain nonprofit community theaters.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a property tax exemption for property owned by a nonprofit entity and operated as a community theater, if the property satisfies all of the following conditions:

- 1. It is used for the purposes for which the nonprofit entity is granted a federal income tax exemption.
- 2. It is located on land that the nonprofit entity owned prior to the bill's effective date or on land donated by a local business owner or by a municipality.
  - 3. It is located on land that is within 20 miles of the Mississippi River.
- 4. It is located on a parcel of land that is at least one-fourth of an acre, but no larger than two acres.
- 5. It includes one or more theaters for the performing arts and the seating capacity of the theater or theaters is not less than 450 persons.
  - 6. It includes facilities that are used for arts education.

Because this bill relates to an exemption from state or local taxes, it may be referred to the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions for a report to be printed as an appendix to the bill.

- 70.11 (45) Nonprofit community theater. All property owned or leased by a corporation, organization, or association that is exempt from taxation under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, if the property satisfies the following conditions:
- (a) It is used for the purposes for which the exemption under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code is granted to the corporation, organization, or association that owns or leases the property.
- (b) It is located on land that the property owner owned prior to the effective date of this paragraph .... [LRB inserts date], or on land donated by a local business owner or by a municipality.
  - (c) It is located on land that is within 20 miles of the Mississippi River.
- (d) It is located on a parcel of land that is at least one-fourth of an acre, but no larger than 2 acres.
- (e) It includes one or more theaters for the performing arts that are operated by the corporation, organization, or association and the seating capacity of the theater or theaters is not less than 450 persons.
  - (f) It includes facilities that are used for arts education.
