SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 215

October 22, 2009 – Offered by Senator HOLPERIN.

1 AN ACT *to create* 70.11 (45) of the statutes; **relating to:** a property tax exemption  
2 for snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle clubs.

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*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This substitute amendment provides a property tax exemption for trail groomers owned by a snowmobile club or an all-terrain vehicle club that is a nonprofit organization.

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 70.11 (45) of the statutes is created to read:

4 70.11 (45) SNOWMOBILE AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE CLUBS. Trail groomers owned  
5 by a snowmobile club or an all-terrain vehicle club that is exempt from taxation  
6 under section 501 (c) (3), (4), or (7) of the Internal Revenue Code.
