Drafting Instructions for a Special License Plate for Marquette University

- Please draft as a non-fundraising license plate.
- Please draft that there are no restrictions on who may purchase the plate (i.e. One does not have to be an alumnus of Marquette University in order to purchase the plate).
- Please draft that Marquette University or an organization on their behalf must pay the \$11,800 data processing and design costs before DOT begins design and production of the Marquette University license plate.
- Please specify that the above payment must be made to the DOT Grants and Gifts account.
- Please specify that the granting of a special license plate by the State of Wisconsin, team is in recognition of the benefit of Marquette University as an institution of higher learning in this state and on behalf of Marquette University's thousand of alumni living in the State of Wisconsin.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, any group or organization may apply to the Department of Transportation (DOT) for designation as an authorized special group. ✓ If the application is approved, members of the authorized special group may obtain special distinguishing registration plates for certain vehicles, including automobiles and motor homes, that are owned or leased by special group members. ✓ A fee, in addition to the regular registration fee for the particular kind of vehicle, is charged for the issuance or reissuance of most special plates.

Before October 2, 1998, authorized special groups whose members may obtain special plates were specifically enumerated in state law. ✓ With certain exceptions, current law provides that specific enumeration in state law of authorized special groups is limited to those special groups enumerated before October 2, 1998. ✓ Current law recognizes as authorized special groups persons interested in obtaining a special plate with any of the following University of Wisconsin campuses on it: Eau Claire, Green Bay, La Crosse, Madison, Milwaukee, Oshkosh, Parkside, Platteville, River Falls, Stevens Point, Stout, Superior, or Whitewater. ✓

This bill establishes an authorized special group specifically enumerated in state law for persons interested in expressing their support for Marquette University and their appreciation of the many benefits Marquette University and its thousands of alumni confer on this state. In addition to the regular vehicle registration fee, special group members are required to pay a \$15 fee for issuance or reissuance of the

special plates. DOT may commence development work, and thereafter issue, these special plates only if DOT receives contributions from Marquette University or other interested persons in the amount of the initial costs of production of these special plates or \$11,800, whichever is less, to cover DOT's costs of implementation.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
