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


Thanks for all of your assistance with this legislation.

After working with Lynita Docken from the Dept. of Commerce, Jeff Beiriger from the Plumbing Contractors, and other interested parties, we have come up with language which addressed all parties' concerns.

Attached is our suggested language. You will see that it is presented as 3 pages, amending Sections 5, 9, and 10 of the bill.

It is critical that the amendment be drafted with these EXACT words. Changing this language will completely change the meaning of these sections...and cause the various parties to once again have problems with the bill.

Legislative Council also recommended deleting Section 11, which called for Rules to be drafted within 12 months after passage of the bill. We have no problem in accepting his recommendation.

SECTION 5. 145.01 (10) (br) of the statutes is created to read:

145.01 (10) (br) "Plumbing" does not include any of the following:

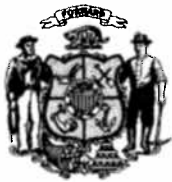
1. A rainwater gutter or downspout down to the point that it discharges into a plumbing system, a subsoil drain, or a foundation drain.
2. A process water reuse system if the process water reuse system is not connected to ~~any~~ a plumbing fixture or appliance ~~or to any stormwater culvert that is located on a roadway easement.~~
3. A stormwater culvert under a roadway or walkway that is placed there only to equalize the water level from one end of the culvert to the other.
- 3 4. The practical installation of process piping within a sewage disposal plant.

SECTION 9. 145.14 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

145.14 (2) (a) ~~Sewer s~~Services. Persons classified under this paragraph may install septic tanks for private sewage systems, may install drain fields designed to serve such septic tanks, and may install sewer service from the septic tank or sewer extensions from mains to the immediate inside or proposed inside foundation wall of the building. Such persons may also install water services, stormwater use systems and reclaimed water systems located outside of the foundation wall of the building.

SECTION 10. 145.14 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

145.14 (2) (b) *Appliances, equipment or devices.* Under this paragraph persons installing a water softeners, treatment device, a water heaters heater, or ~~other items~~ any other item in connection with ~~the~~ a water supply distribution system including a stormwater use or reclaim water system ~~or a water distribution systems~~ which does ~~system that does~~ not require a direct connection to a ~~the~~ drain systems system are limited to making ~~connection~~ connections to existing installations. There shall be no drilling, tapping or direct connection made to any waste or drain pipe to serve items installed under this section.
