SECTION #.

Section #. 43.54 (1) (am) of the statutes is amended to read:

board consisting of the president of the board of school directors or his or her designee, the superintendent of schools or his or her designee, a member of the county board of supervisors who resides in the county but outside the city, 3 alderpersons and 6 public members. One of the public members appointed by the mayor under this paragraph shall be designated by the president of the common council on the 3rd Tuesday in April for a 4-year term.
