- **SECTION 1.** 10.66 (2) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 6 10.66 **(2)** (a) 1. December 1 preceding the spring election is the earliest date
- 7 nomination papers may be circulated for candidates running in the spring election.
- 8 See ss. 8.05 (3) (a) and (4) (b) and 8.10 (2).

**Section 3.** 10.66 (3) (aw) of the statutes is renumbered 10.66 (3) (aw) 1. and amended to read:

10.66 (3) (aw) 1. The deadline for a city or village to decide to hold a spring primary or for the spring election is 3 days after the first Tuesday in January preceding the spring election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2) and 8.11 (1) (a) and 8.11 (1m) (a).

2. The deadline for electors of a city to file a petition requesting a spring primary for the spring election is 3 days after the first Tuesday in January preceding the spring election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2) and 8.11 (1) (a) and (c).

Note: 2007 Wis. Act 83, section 4, makes the deadline for deciding to hold a spring primary applicable to villages.

**Section 4.** 10.70 (1u) (a) of the statutes is created to read:

10.70 (1u) DECEMBER. (a) *December 1*. The deadline for electors of a village to file a petition requesting a primary for the spring election is December 1 preceding the spring election. See s. 8.11 (1m) (c).

Note: Creates provision consistent with 2007 Wis. Act 83, section 4.

**SECTION 5.** 10.70 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

10.70 **(2)** (b) *3 days after first Tuesday in January.* The deadline for electors of a city to file a petition -a city requesting a primary for the spring election is 3 days after the first Tuesday in January preceding the spring election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2) and 8.11 (1) (c).
