Hi Aaron –

I was involved in a meeting this morning with Sen. Holperin – the Sen. Comm. Chair that SB 392 is in right now. He was negotiating a compromise between our office and Paul Nilsen at DOT.

Although the Dept. still isn't happy – we came to the conclusion that we need a substitute amendment for the bill that will simply carve out Pinzgauers, 25 years or older, as vehicles that will be allowed to be registered as trucks with unrestricted use.

Below is the description from DOT of how they list the Pinzgauer in their registration process.

Senator Holperin has SB 392 scheduled for an executive session for next Thursday – February 4th.

Please do not rely on our makes, because Pinzgauer has a long history of manufacturers, and could change in the future. See http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Pinzgauer_High_Mobility_All-Terrain_Vehicle

I would hate to deny a Pinzgauer registration just because it was made by BAE Systems, for example, not by Steyr Puch.

Aaron Gary of LRB can probably come up with a good definition, perhaps using the wikipedia. It may be enough to say simply "Pinzgauer" or "Pinzgauer, including those manufactured by..."
