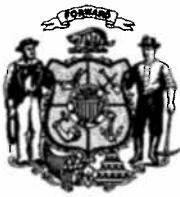

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, an aging and disability resource center provides services to certain elderly and disabled individuals, including information and referral services related to long-term care and eligibility screening for the Family Care Program benefit. A county department or an aging unit that is either an agency of county or tribal government or a unit within a county department may apply to the Department of Health Services to operate an aging and disability resource center. This bill allows aging units that are private, nonprofit corporations to apply to operate an aging and disability resource center.
