4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 946.41 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	946.41 (1) Whoever Except as provided in subs. (2m) and (2r), whoever
6	knowingly resists or obstructs an officer while such officer is doing any act in an
7	official capacity and with lawful authority, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
8	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 946.41 (2r) of the statutes is created to read:
9	946.41 (2r) Whoever violates sub. (1) and causes substantial bodily harm to an
10	officer is guilty of a Class H felony.
