1 AN ACT ...; **relating to:** causing injury to a law enforcement officer while resisting
2 or obstructing an officer and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 946.41 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 946.41 (1) ~~Whoever~~ Except as provided in subs. (2m) and (2r), whoever
5 knowingly resists or obstructs an officer while such officer is doing any act in an
6 official capacity and with lawful authority, is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

7 SECTION 2. 946.41 (2r) of the statutes is created to read:
8 946.41 (2r) Whoever violates sub. (1) and causes bodily harm to an officer is
9 guilty of a Class H felony.
