SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2009 SENATE BILL 264

October 5, 2009 – Offered by Senator SULLIVAN.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	${f 1.}$ Page 1, line 2: delete "and all–terrain vehicles" and substitute ", all–terrain
3	vehicles, and other off-highway vehicles".
4	2. Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:
5	"SECTION 1g. 23.119 of the statutes is created to read:
6	23.119 Consent to use certain off-highway vehicles. (1) In this section:
7	(a) "All–terrain vehicle" has the meaning given in s. 340.01 (2g).
8	(b) "Off-highway vehicle" means a motor-driven craft or vehicle principally
9	manufactured for off-highway use but does not include a snowmobile or all terrain
10	vehicle.
11	(c) "Snowmobile" has the meaning given in s. 340.01 (58a).

(2) No person may operate an off-highway vehicle on private property without
 the consent of the owner of the property.

- 3 (3) No person may operate an off-highway vehicle on public property that is
 4 posted as closed to the operation of off-highway vehicles or on which the operation
 5 of an off-highway vehicle is prohibited by law.".
- 6 **3.** Page 1, line 4: delete "**1**" and substitute "**1r**".
- 7 **4.** Page 1, line 6: after that line insert:

8 **"SECTION 1t.** 350.10 (1) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 350.10 (1) (f) On the private property of another without the consent of the 10 owner or lessee. Failure to post private property does not imply consent for 11 snowmobile use. Any other motor-driven craft or vehicle principally manufactured 12 for off-highway use shall at all times have the consent of the owner before operation 13 of such craft or vehicle on private lands.".
