### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the Department of Commerce (Commerce) to consult with the Economic Policy Board (board) in Commerce prior to awarding a grant or loan from the Forward Innovation Fund (FIF). Commerce must also consult with the board to develop policies, standards and rules in connection with the award of grants or loans under FIF.

Currently, the board is required to determine whether to award a grant or loan from the Wisconsin Development Fund (WDF), and Commerce must obtain approval from the board prior to promulgating rules governing WDF.

This bill eliminates the role of the board in the award of grants or loans from FIF and WDF and also from the development of policies, standards, and rules governing FIF and WDF. The bill vests all responsibilities for FIF and WDF in

Commerce. The bill requires the board to consult with Commerce on strategic economic policy for the state and suggest legislation to accomplish strategic economic policy objectives.


