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

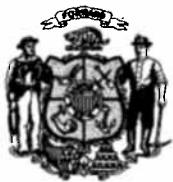

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 11, line 23: after that line insert:

3 "6. No claimant may claim a credit under this subsection if the claimant has
4 hired an alien, as defined in 8 USC 1101 (a) (3), in violation of 8 USC 1324a (a) in the
5 taxable year in which the claimant claims a credit under this subsection or in any
6 of the 5 taxable years immediately preceding the taxable year in which the claimant
7 claims a credit under this subsection. For purposes of administering this subsection,
8 the department shall promulgate rules for determining whether a claimant has
9 violated 8 USC 1324a (a)."

10 **2.** Page 15, line 2: after that line insert:

11 "6. No claimant may claim a credit under this subsection if the claimant has
12 hired an alien, as defined in 8 USC 1101 (a) (3), in violation of 8 USC 1324a (a) in the
13 taxable year in which the claimant claims a credit under this subsection or in any

1 of the 5 taxable years immediately preceding the taxable year in which the claimant
2 claims a credit under this subsection. For purposes of administering this subsection,
3 the department shall promulgate rules for determining whether a claimant has
4 violated 8 USC 1324a (a).”.

5 **3.** Page 18, line 6: after that line insert:

6 “6. No claimant may claim a credit under this subsection if the claimant has
7 hired an alien, as defined in 8 USC 1101 (a) (3), in violation of 8 USC 1324a (a) in the
8 taxable year in which the claimant claims a credit under this subsection or in any
9 of the 5 taxable years immediately preceding the taxable year in which the claimant
10 claims a credit under this subsection. For purposes of administering this subsection,
11 the department shall promulgate rules for determining whether a claimant has
12 violated 8 USC 1324a (a).”.
