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

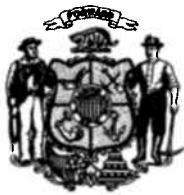
Hi Tracy and Chris,

We would like a bill to provide \$710,000 GPR to the Wisconsin Workforce Development Association for the purposes of purchasing the infrastructure to install a fully integrated video conferencing system to be used by at least 20 job centers across the state for collaborative meetings, career guidance workshops and other purposes as determined by the WWDA. Require that the WWDA enter into an agreement with Wisconsin stating they will operate this technology for at least five years and they will invest any funds saved as a result of this technology that not used to pay for the operation of the video conferencing system to assist unemployed and underemployed workers.

This bill requires the Department of Commerce (department) to award grants to the Wisconsin Workforce Development Association (association) for purchasing and installing a fully integrated video conferencing system to be used by at least 20 job centers across the state for collaborative meetings, career guidance workshops, and other purposes. The total amount of grants awarded under the bill may not exceed \$710,000. The bill provides \$710,000 in general purpose revenue (GPR) to fund the grants.

Under the bill, the department must enter into an agreement with the association that requires the association to operate the system for at least 5 years after the date of purchase and to invest any resulting savings, minus the cost of operating the system, to assist unemployed and underemployed workers.

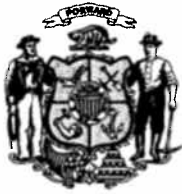
Hi Lisa

Per our telephone conversation, I will change the appropriation in this bill (s. 20.143 (1) (ep)) from a biennial appropriation to an annual appropriation, meaning all \$700,000 will be appropriated in the 2009-10 fiscal year. Any amount not spent by June 30, 2010 will lapse to the general fund.

As currently drafted, Chris repeals the appropriation June 30, 2011. Do you want the appropriation to be repealed June 30, 2010 instead?
