Ian,

First, it does not appear that the amendment has been offered, so the amendment is not a public document from the LRB's standpoint. If you could indicate that you have a copy of the amendment (such as by telling me what language is contained on page 2 line 14 of LRBA1558/2) or if you allow me to ask the amendment's author for approval to use the language, then I can allow you to use its language. (Otherwise, I will have to wait until the amendment is offered.)

Once I can use the amendment's language, I can either give you a companion bill that incorporates the amendment (as you requested) or I can give you both a companion bill and a companion amendment. The difference is that, if I incorporate the amendment into your bill, then I must include the changes made in the amendment into the analysis. If someone compares the Assembly and Senate bills it will not be immediately apparent that they are identical, even though they are. If I give you both a companion bill and a companion amendment, then it is obvious they are identical but it is more paperwork for you to keep track of. I can do either and it is up to you. Please let me know which you prefer.
