First, it does not appear that the amendment has been offered, so the amendment is not a public document from the LRB's standpoint. If you could indicate that you have a copy of the amendment (such as by telling me what language is contained on page 2 line 14 of LRBa1558/2) or if you allow me to ask the amendment's author for approval to use the language, then I can allow you to use its language. (Otherwise, I will have to wait until the amendment is offered.)

Once I can use the amendment's language, I can either give you a companion bill that incorporates the amendment (as you requested) or I can give you both a companion bill and a companion amendment. The difference is that, if I incorporate the amendment into your bill, then I must include the changes made in the amendment into the analysis. If someone compares the Assembly and Senate bills it will not be immediately apparent that they are identical, even though they are. If I give you both a companion bill and a companion amendment, then it is obvious they are identical but it is more paperwork for you to keep track of. I can do either and it is up to you. Please let me know which you prefer.

 - **2.** Page 3, line 1: after "sub." insert "(3m) or".
 - **3.** Page 4, line 3: after "54.25" insert "(2) (d) 2. ab. and ac".
 - **4.** Page 4, line 3: after that line insert:
 - "(cm) If a health care agent is acting on behalf of a resident, the health care agent shall give informed consent in accordance with the desires of the resident as expressed in the power of attorney for health care instrument under ch. 155 or, if the resident's desires are unknown, in accordance with s. 155.20 (5).".

"(fm) At the time a resident, or a person acting on behalf of the resident, signs
the informed consent form, the nursing home shall orally inform the resident, or the

consent, in writing, at any time.
2. That, unless consent is withdrawn sooner, the informed consent is valid for
the period specified on the informed consent form or for 15 months from the date on
which the resident, or the person acting on behalf of the resident, signs the form,
whichever is shorter.".
6. Page 4, line 17: after that line insert:
"(3m) A nursing home is not required to obtain written informed consent before
administering a psychotropic medication to a resident under sub. (3) if the
prescription for the psychotropic medication is written or reauthorized while the
resident is off of the nursing home's premises.".
7. Page 5, line 17: after that line insert:
"(5) This section does not abridge any rights that a resident has under s. 51.61
