Senator Miller:

2007 SB 168 only permitted *one* senior with the next highest grade point average (GPA) to be designated as an alternate, but obviously more than one pupil may be tied with the next highest GPA. Accordingly, this redraft permits *one or more* of the remaining seniors with the next highest GPA to be designated as alternates in case more than one scholar or alternate with the same GPA is not eligible for a scholarship.
