Dear Senator Hansen,

This letter is in response to the enclosed letter you sent me dated August 28, 2007. I believe you had a misunderstanding with regards to what I was asking of you.

My employer (AT&T Wisconsin) does not permit its employees to participate in random company sponsored drawings due to WI state regulations. I am asking you to work towards a resolution amending these regulations and allowing corporate employees to be treated equally amongst our peers in other states.

I have researched the reasons why and this is the company's response:

There is a lot of history with respect to this issue. Numerous internal attorneys analyzed the Wisconsin law. In addition, we sought an outside law firm opinion on the issue. Lastly, we sought an opinion from the Attorney General of Wisconsin. The advice was consistent on the issue of whether our WI employees could participate in "sweepstakes", "drawings" and the like in connection with our ERIC program. All concluded that a change of state law was required in order to legally allow an ERIC type sweepstakes involving the elements of both chance and consideration (requiring employees to make referrals in order to qualify). Furthermore, we concluded that a reasonable alternative was to reward top performers in WI.

Please see the enclosed flyer which depicts the current employee contest AT&T is offering. I have circled in red the paragraphs that state WI employees are not permitted to play by the same rules as everyone else.

I appreciate your time in this matter. Please respond at your earliest convenience.





Do you have any further information as to whether the AT&T attorneys believe that the gambling issue may be resolved with a statutory change alone, i.e. that there is no constitutional problem.

With respect to the specifics of the AT&T Referral Program contest, are employees otherwise compensated for making referrals? Is it their job to make referrals and sell AT&T services or are the referrals something they just do on the side to participate in the contest?

For the Wisconsin P2R program, what are the points that a Wisconsin winner receives? I take they are not points to be entered in a prize drawing. Are they points that the winner uses to "purchase" some prize. The reason I ask is that I am trying to understand why the Wisconsin Program is legal. If I understand what is going on, it is because there is no chance involved.

I need to look more at the case law on gambling, but I think ultimately I have to draft an exception that says that whatever an employee does to earn prize drawing points does not constitute "consideration" for purposes of the gambling laws. Any further description of what an employee does to earn points and how he or she is otherwise compensated by the company will help me craft that exception.

Mr. Wadd,

I'll do my best to answer your questions below, however, I'd like it noted that I am in no way providing legal answers on behalf of AT&T and they are subject to interpretation.

- 1. Employees are given 'points' for successful referrals. It is not our 'job' to make referrals, it is strictly voluntary.
- 2. The points we receive are awarded based on the types of products the customer purchases. They are <u>not</u> entered into a drawing and they may be used to 'purchase' a prize from an online catalog. There is no 'chance' involved.

MY interpretation of the WI anti-gaming law is that it is preventing me, as an employee, to be eligible to receive awards from my employer when large contests are run. Such as the examples I have previously forwarded you. I realize the importance of these laws, however, do not feel that employees of corporations such as mine should be subject to them. We are also taxed on the 'prizes' we purchase/receive so WI is losing out on that revenue by not allowing us to be eligible.

Please let me know if this helps or if there is anything else I can do.
