## 2009 WISCONSIN ACT 389

AN ACT *to amend* 350.10 (1) (gm); and *to create* 350.10 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** a speed limit for the operation of snowmobiles during the hours of darkness.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 350.10 (1) (gm) of the statutes is amended to read:

350.10(1) (gm) During the hours of darkness at a rate

of speed exceeding 55 miles per hour. This paragraph does not apply after July 1, 2010.

**SECTION 2.** 350.10 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

350.10 (3) Subsection (1) (gm) does not apply to a person operating a snowmobile while competing in a sanctioned race or derby.
