



## 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 903

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 167.21 of the statutes; **relating to:** safety standards for  
2             movable soccer goals, granting rule-making authority, and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 167.21 of the statutes is created to read:

4             **167.21 Movable soccer goals. (1)** In this section:

5             (a) “Commission” means the federal consumer product safety commission.

6             (b) “Department” means the department of commerce.

7             (c) “Movable soccer goal” means a freestanding structure that consists of at  
8             least 2 upright posts, a crossbar, and support bars and that is designed to be used as  
9             a soccer goal and to be movable to different locations.

10            **(2)** The department shall promulgate rules that establish safety standards for  
11            anchoring and securing, and using counterweights on, movable soccer goals. The

1 standards shall be consistent with guidelines for movable soccer goal safety  
2 published by the commission in January 1995.

3 **(3)** No person may erect a movable soccer goal on public land unless the person  
4 erects the goal in the manner required by the rules promulgated under sub. (2).

5 **(4)** A person who violates sub. (3) is subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$500.

6 **SECTION 2. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,  
7 except as follows:

8 (1) The treatment of section 167.21 (3) and (4) of the statutes takes effect on the  
9 first day of the 13th month beginning after the effective date of this subsection.
