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

Describe the problem to be corrected by the legislation:

Graduates of non-accredited veterinary medical schools can currently qualify for a license in Wisconsin by demonstrating equivalence through the Educational Commission for Foreign Veterinary Graduates (ECFVG) program. The ECFVG is offered by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA). Many states allow applicants to qualify by equivalence by completion of the Program for the Assessment of Veterinary Equivalence (PAVE) program, in addition to ECFVG. PAVE is offered by the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB). By making another equivalency track available to applicants, more veterinarians could qualify for a license to practice veterinary medicine in Wisconsin.

How should the problem be corrected?

The statute(s) that recognize(s) the ECFVG program should be amended to also recognize PAVE.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: requirements for initial licensure as a veterinarian.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Veterinary Examining Board (board) in the Department of Regulation and Licensing (department) may issue a veterinary license to an applicant for an initial license who passes an examination conducted by the board, pays a fee to the department, and is either a graduate of a veterinary college approved by the board or has successfully completed the Educational Commission for Foreign Veterinary Graduates certification program of the American Veterinary Medical Association.

x This bill authorizes the board to issue an initial veterinary license to a person who passes an examination conducted by the board, pays a fee to the department, and has successfully completed the Program for the Advancement of Veterinary Equivalence offered by the American Association of Veterinary State Boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 453.06 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 453.06 (1) Except as provided under s. 453.072, veterinary licenses shall be
4 issued only to persons who successfully pass an examination conducted by the
5 examining board and pay the fee specified in s. 440.05 (1). An applicant for an initial

1 license shall be a graduate of a veterinary college ~~which~~ that has been approved by
 2 the examining board or have successfully completed either the educational
 3 commission for foreign veterinary graduates certification program of the American
 4 Veterinary Medical Association or the program for the ^{assessment} (advancement) of veterinary
 5 educational equivalence offered by the American Association of Veterinary State Boards.
 6 Persons who qualify for examination may be granted temporary permits to engage
 7 in the practice of veterinary medicine in the employment and under the supervision
 8 of a veterinarian until the results of the next examination conducted by the
 9 examining board are available. In case of failure at any examination, the applicant
 10 shall have the privilege of taking subsequent examinations, upon the payment of
 11 another fee for each examination.
