Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill limits the use of direct annexations and also limits the issues that form the basis for a circuit court challenge of certain annexations.

Under this bill, some claims may be brought that would otherwise be ineligible. The bill also limits the issues that may form the basis for certain annexation challenges. Although additional workload could be generated if more actions are filed in circuit court, no significant impact is expected upon circuit court operations as a result of this bill.
