Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

PROVISIONS OF THE BILL

This bill establishes a special license plate to raise funds for the Lions Clubs of Wisconsin. The bill requires that the plate display a logo or image of the lion associated with the Lions Club International. The plate would be available to any person interested in supporting the Lions Clubs of Wisconsin.

The bill establishes a contribution fee of \$25 per year, in addition to the regular registration fee for the vehicle. Contributions are given to Wisconsin Lions Foundation, after the Transportation Fund retains up to \$43,200 to fund DMV's costs to implement the plate. Like all special plates, a \$15 one-time fee would be charged for issuance or reissuance of the plate. The bill makes a one-time increase to the DMV appropriation of \$43,200 to fund DMV's costs to implement the plate.

The bill requires DOT to enter into an agreement with the Wisconsin Lions Foundation, Inc., for payment of the contribution funds. Wisconsin Lions Foundation and associated organizations would provide without fee any license approval or trademark approval used for the license plate. Wisconsin Lions Foundation would annually report to the Attorney General and the Legislature on its use of the contribution funds.

The bill has a delayed effective date of first day of 7th month after publication.

FISCAL IMPACT

DMV will incur one-time cost of \$23,700. This cost is incurred before any plates are sold, and regardless of how many plates are sold. Cost includes \$23,000 for data processing system modifications, and \$700 for graphic design. The bill makes a one-time increase to the DMV appropriation, and provides that the Transportation Fund retain contributions, up to \$43,200, to fund the initial cost.

On-going cost to DMV would be minimal and could be absorbed within DMV's budget. On-going revenue increase to the Transportation Fund would be minimal.
