Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the Law Enforcement Standards (Chapter LES 2, Wis. Admin. Code), the Division of State Patrol currently completes a psychological evaluation on final candidates for the State Patrol Trooper/Inspector classifications.

The current psychological evaluation costs \$299 per person. This includes the administration and analysis of the written psychological examination, the administration and analysis of the oral psychological exam and any additional costs providing analysis to State Patrol management.

The overall cost per year depends on the size of the recruit class for that particular year. Since the Department currently conducts and pays for these psychological evaluations, the bill would not impose any new costs on DOT.
