Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires suspected drug activity on the part of a caregiver or nonclient resident of a child care provider to be reported to an immediate supervisor and to the sheriff, and suspected or threatened child abuse or neglect on the part of such an individual to be reported under the child abuse and neglect reporting law and providing a penalty.

The Department expects implementation of this bill to have no fiscal impact on the Department.

County and municipal human services, social services, or law enforcement agencies may see an increase in workload and costs dependent on the number of incidents of drug activity or suspected child abuse or neglect that is reported to their agencies. DHS is not able to estimate the possible increase in staff time or costs for these entities.
