Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2009 Assembly Bill (AB) 698 has no new fiscal impact on the Department of Administration or State Building Commission. AB 698 amends the 2009-11 Authorized State Building Program to authorize \$17,000,000 in existing general fund supported borrowing authority to finance the renovation of Carlson Hall at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater.

AB 698 reallocates borrowing authority from previously authorized projects that have come in under budget.
