<b>Description</b> Requiring the Department of Transportation to establish rules allowing living will and health care power of attorney information to be included on driver's licenses, providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures, and granting rule-making authority		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law the Department designs living will and health care power of attorney forms and distributes the forms to health care professionals, hospitals, nursing homes, county clerks, local bar associates and to individuals who request the forms.

AB 76 requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to establish rules under which individuals with living wills or health care power of attorney forms can add information to their drivers' licenses regarding the identity of those individuals who have custody of the living wills or are agents under a power of attorney form. DOT is also required to post the Department's forms on its website.

This bill is not anticipated to have a fiscal effect on the Department.
