<b>Description</b> Professional land surveyors, the practice of professional land surveying, surveying land abutting navigable waters, and granting rule-making authority					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

After July 1, 2018, the bill would require state employees to obtain a license or permit to engage in the practice of professional land surveying, whereas state employees are exempt from the certificate of registration and permit requirements under current law. Because state employees are currently exempt, the Department of Natural Resources does not have an accurate way to determine how many existing employees may be affected by this change, but the number is estimated to be very small. The Department would incur some additional costs to pay license fees for any employee who is required to have the license/certification as a condition of their employment. Fees are not specified in the bill, but according to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, the current registration fee is \$53 for the first two years, and \$77 for each two-year renewal.
