Description Creating an individual income tax checkoff for the Special Olympics Wisconsin, Inc., and making an appropriation									

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 233 creates an income tax checkoff for designations to Special Olympics Wisconsin, Inc. The bill also creates a new appropriation [20.255(3)(ge)] in the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to receive checkoff revenues and make payments to Special Olympics.

DPI will occur minor costs to administer the new payments that can be absorbed.

With the new appropriation, DPI could realize an increase in revenues. Each year after contributions from the checkoff are calculated, administrative expenses will be deducted and the remaining revenue will be deposited to the new appropriation. It is not possible to know how many persons will participate in the income tax checkoff or the amount of money that persons will contribute. Therefore, the fiscal effect is indeterminate.

DPI currently has an appropriation, WI Stat. 20.255 (3)(fg), that provides GPR funds to WI Special Olympics, Inc. to be used to offset its administrative costs. This current appropriation would not be affected by Senate Bill 233.
