## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under federal law, certain local units of government are authorized to issue Recovery Zone Facility Bonds. This bill waives that allocation to local units of government and requires the Department of Commerce to develop a system to reallocate the allocation. Commerce would be able to develop this system, and administer the allocation, within current budgetary authority.

Local governments will incur no costs above those which they would have incurred under current law.
