Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-664 requires that, under the Clean Water Fund and the Safe Drinking Water Loan Programs, the Department of Administration (DOA) and the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) provide for increased federal subsidies to be in the form of principal loan forgiveness.
