Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires preparation time to be a mandatory subject of collective bargaining in school districts.

State fiscal effect: None.

Local fiscal effect:

The impact on school districts is indeterminate. Creating a new mandatory subject of collective bargaining will add one more item on the list of things to be discussed and bargained for under the Municipal Employment Relations Act in school districts. Many school districts already bargain for preparation time and may already consider preparation time to be a condition of employment (already a mandatory subject of bargaining).
