Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates preparation time as a new mandatory subject of collective bargaining under the Municipal Employment Relations Act (MERA) in school districts.

The bill has no direct fiscal impact on the Office of State Employment Relations' operations or programs because this bill pertains only to school districts governed by the Municipal Employment Relations Act (MERA). Our office handles collective bargaining on behalf of the State of Wisconsin as the employer and is governed by a different statutory provision, State Employment Labor Relations Act (SELRA), Chapter 111.80, Wis.Stats. Subsequently, our office does not collect data to estimate the fiscal impact of this bill on local governments since that is not within the authority of our office. The fiscal effect on local governments is indeterminate.
