

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 84 [2009 Assembly Bill 112]

HIRSP Eligibility

Act 84 modifies the statutes that relate to determining Health Insurance Risk-Sharing Plan (HIRSP) eligibility. Under prior law, one way in which a person may become eligible for HIRSP is receiving and submitting to the HIRSP Authority a notice of rejection from two or more insurers based wholly or partially on medical underwriting considerations within nine months prior to making the application. Act 84 modifies this to require such a notice of rejection of coverage from just one or more insurer.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on December 16, 2009.
