



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

**2009 Wisconsin Act 104**  
[2009 Assembly Bill 364]

**Council on Offender Reentry**

2009 Wisconsin Act 28, the Biennial Budget Act, created the Council on Offender Reentry. The council is required, among other duties, to annually submit a report to the Governor, any relevant state agencies, as identified by the council, and the Chief Clerk of each house of the Legislature for distribution to the Legislature that provides information on the progress of the council's work.

2009 Wisconsin Act 104 requires the report to additionally include information on all of the following:

- Any impact the council's work has had on recidivism.
- The effectiveness of agency coordination and communication.
- The implementation of a reentry strategic plan.
- Recommendations on legislative initiatives and policy initiatives that are consistent with the duties of the council.

**Effective date:** Act 104 takes effect on February 19, 2010.
